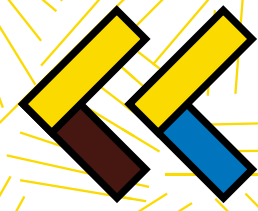

“Yebo! Development of the Internationalization of PhD Studies in South-Africa” is an Erasmus+ funded project focused on further developing the internationalisation of doctoral education in South African universities.

Three approaches contribute to achieving this objective:

- › A web-based portal that encompasses research and funding networks, identification of funding opportunities;*
- › Themed conferences focusing on best practices for the internationalisation and promotion of doctoral education;*
- › Training sessions with a focus on supervision capacities.*

The EUA’s “Framework for the Internationalisation of Doctoral Education” (FRINDOC) has inspired Yebo! consisting of four principles:

- › research capacity and capability;*
- › international profile;*
- › institutional structures;*
- › and mobility support.*
